

## IBEW Local 332 Annual Safety Award



**Purpose:** The IBEW Local 332 Safety Award is an annual recognition of an IBEW Local 332 member or members who demonstrates a conscious effort towards the safety of others on the job. It is the purpose of this award to recognize an individual, or group of individuals, for their efforts to promote, advocate, improve, educate, or show sustained commitment to the safety of others on the job. It may also be a recognition of an act of courage or perseverance for the safety of one or more people on the job or in the community.

Eligibility: The nominee(s) must be an IBEW Local 332 member in good standing.

**Criteria:** Nominees must also satisfy at least two of the following criteria in the previous year: •Implementing a safety program in the workplace or on the job

•Having an active role, and being a strong advocate for safety on the job or in the workplace

- •Demonstrating significant improvement from previous conditions on the job or in the workplace •Consistently maintaining an active and successful safety program
- •Reporting, correcting or providing a solution to a significant safety issue on the jobsite or in the workplace
- Shows excellence in any matter related to jobsite safety
- Was courageous in a safety matter, whether it was a single act or in a cumulative manner
  Achieve recognition for outstanding service to the safety of others on the jobsite, the workplace, or in the community

**Nominations:** The IBEW Local 332 Safety Committee will each year announce the dates of the nomination period to submit a name or names for this award.

Submissions must be made in writing, and sent to and be received by the Local 332 Safety Committee by the announced deadline.

The information sent in should include the following:

- a. The name of the member or members
- b. The date or time period of the safety contribution being addressed
- c. The name and location of the jobsite or worksite

d. A brief, yet detailed description of the commitment to safety being cited for recognition which could include statements from co-workers, photos, articles, reference to policies or procedures
